

**TEACHERS AND PARENTS ASSOCIATION OF SARADA (TAPAS)**

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## **A. BACKGROUND**

1. In 2002, several parents took the initiative to form an association that could allow them to play a more constructive role in the activities and objectives of Sarada Kindergarten. The association intended to find ways to participate and support the kindergarten actively so that they could assist in inculcating the strong values of Sarada Kindergarten and allow children who leave Sarada to maintain their bonds of friendship and affinity to the school.
2. February 2003 saw the first meeting of some 15 parents and kindergarten staff. It was a humble beginning but the burning desire to create an organization which would be a pivotal support group for Sarada Kindergarten was too great to ignore.
3. The group registered as a society on 9<sup>th</sup> October 2003. On 29<sup>th</sup> August 2004, it was officially launched as the Teachers and Parents Association of Sarada (TAPAS) with much fanfare by our then Minister for Education Dr Tharman Shamugaratnam.

## **B. OBJECTIVES**

From its inception, TAPAS has tirelessly strived to achieve its objectives which are:

- (a) To provide scholarships, prizes and financial assistance to students and teachers of the kindergarten.
- (b) To promote the welfare of the kindergarten, its students and teachers.
- (c) To facilitate the active interaction between the parents and students in various activities of the kindergarten.
- (d) To undertake various fund raising and other activities for the support of the kindergarten and/or association.
- (e) To promote the advancement and improvement of its members physically, intellectually, socially and morally.
- (f) To develop a true spirit of loyalty and love for the Alma Mater.
- (g) To secure the co-operation and active interest of pupils in carrying out the aims and objectives of the kindergarten.
- (h) To promote the ideals of true citizenship and to promote the feeling of comradeship among the races.

## **E. ACTIVITIES FROM 1ST APRIL 2024 TO 31ST MARCH 2025**

### **1. 2024 Bursary Awards**

Participants enjoyed a leisurely stroll, followed by games and a chance to interact and bond over breakfast. It was a delightful opportunity for families to connect and strengthen the sense of community.
